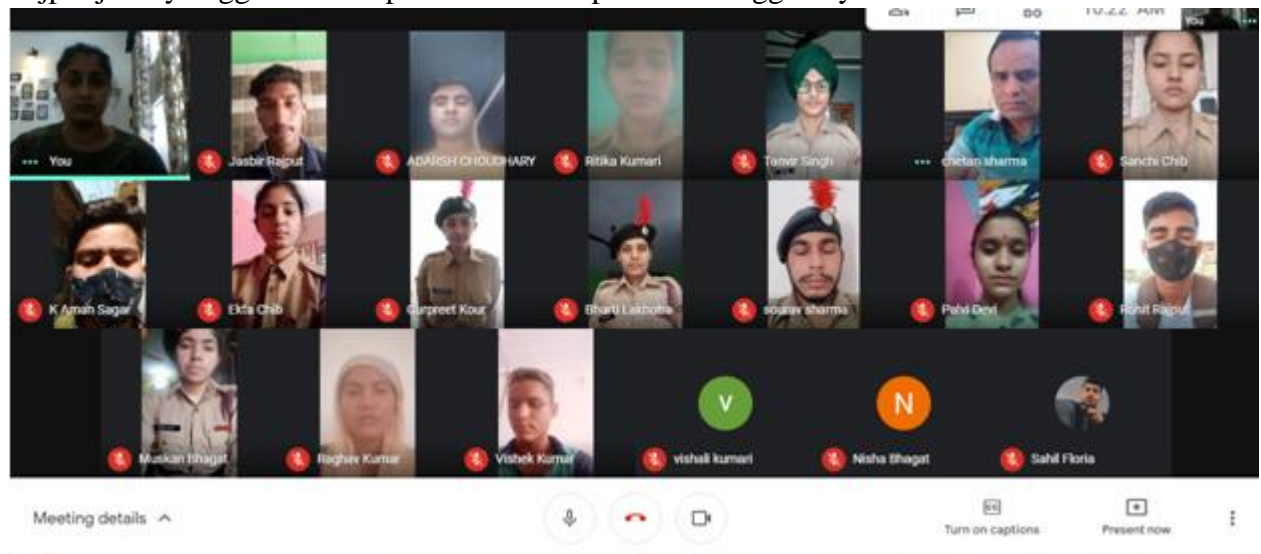


Date 21.06.2021

Activities performed: Participation in National Anthem Singing Competition

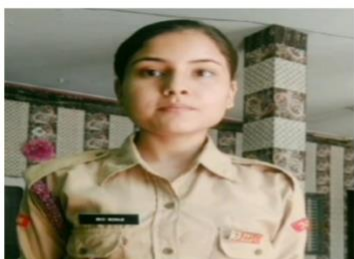
A total of 21 girl NCC cadets participated in National Anthem Singing Competition on Rastragaan.in and received certificates of participation.

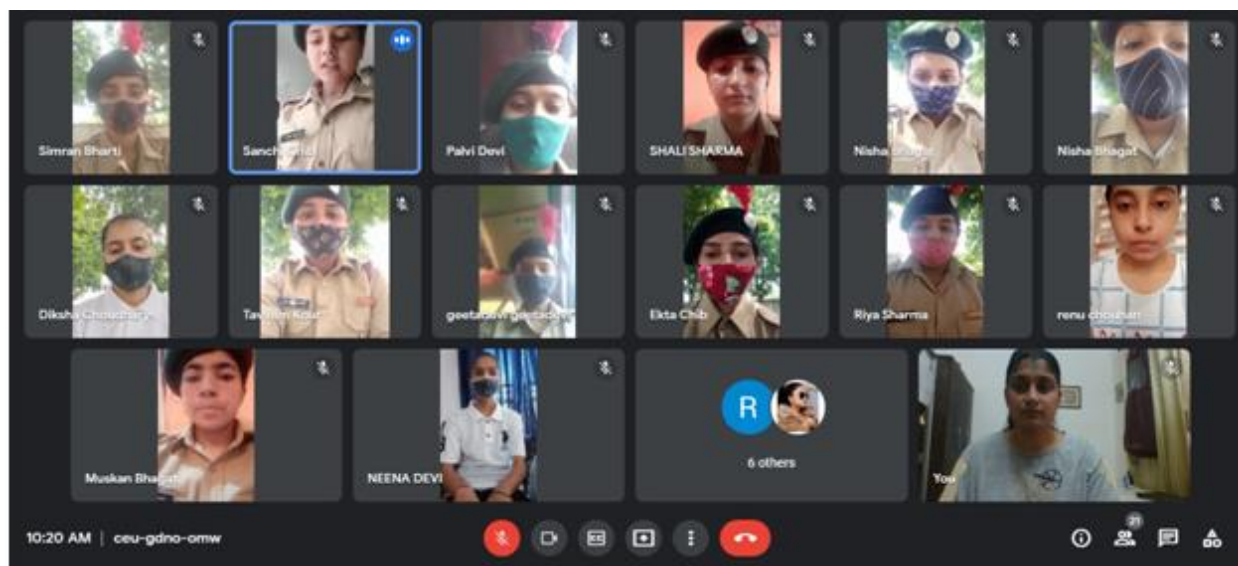
